Quiz Properties

- Name quiz
- Link to grade item, if desired (auto export)
- Check **Score** to display score immediately after quiz is submitted.
- Fill in other options
- Save**

Quiz Restrictions

- Restrictions are for the whole class
- Set quiz start and end date
- Set a time limit (default is 2 hours)
- Enforce time limit (option) and show clock
- Set grace period (time before quiz is **late**)
- Save**

Special Access (on Restrictions tab)

- For individuals
- Choose the special options (time limit, start and end dates)
- Select the individuals from list of participants
- Save**

- Set the number of attempts
- If more than one, select grade calculation from dropdown list
- Save**

- Message – this is a default message. You can create your own custom message
- User’s Answers –
 - Show none
 - Show all (must be selected to √ “show correct”
 - Display of “Statistics” is optional

Question Library

- Begin tests/quizzes by creating a pool of questions in the *Question Library*
- Group questions by unit, subject, or ???
Grouping them into folders as you would organize files on your computer
- Questions can be imported into the Question Library from any quizzes already created

Common Features Among Question Types

- an optional **Title** field
- the **Add Feedback** area
- the **Question Hint** field
- Preview** to view your question
- Save** the question and return to the main screen
- Save & New** to continue creating questions

Multiple Choice Questions

- Assign point value (and difficulty)
- Enter Question in text box
- Add an image if needed
- Choose an enumeration and display style
 - Horizontal, vertical, drop down
- Add possible answers (click random if wanted)
- Set the weight of the answers (usually one is set to 100%)

- Assign point value (and difficulty)
- Enter Question in text box
- Add an image if needed
- Choose a display and enumeration style
- Set the weight of the answers (usually one is set to 100%)

Long Answer

- Assign point value (and difficulty)
- Enter Question in text box
- Add an image if needed
- Set size of input text box (rows and columns)
- Text in the **Initial Text** box will be displayed to the user in the text box
- Text in the **Answer Key** box will be displayed to the user in Grade Quiz area for grading purposes only.

Short Answer

- Assign point value (and difficulty)
- Enter Question in text box
- Choose the size of the input box by using the drop-downs beside rows and columns
- Click the **Add Answer** icon.
- Type the answer in the text field and choose the weight.
- Continue adding all accepted answers and weights.
- Add an image if needed
- Click **Preview** to view your question. Click **Save** to save the question and return to the main screen or click **Save & New** to continue creating short answer questions

- Assign point value (and difficulty)

- Choose your blank size in the drop-down.

- Add an image if needed

Matching Question

- Assign point value (and difficulty)
- Enter Question in text box
- Add an image if needed
- Choose a display and enumeration style

Matching Question cont.

- Choose a marking format: Equally Weighted, All or nothing (must have all the possible correct answers or else receive no marks) or Right minus wrong (the number of right answers chosen is subtracted from the number of wrong answers chosen to get an overall mark for the question)
- Type the question choices in the text boxes. If you wish to add more choices, click the **Add Choice** button
- Type the matches in the text boxes. If you wish to add more choices, click the **Add Match** button
- Use the drop-down beside a "match" to select the corresponding "choice" number. This will create the "matched" pairs.

Ordering Question

- Assign point value (and difficulty)
- Enter Question in text box
- Add an image if needed
- Choose a marking format: Equally Weighted, All or nothing (must have all the possible correct answers or else receive no marks) or Right minus wrong (the number of right answers chosen is subtracted from the number of wrong answers chosen to get an overall mark for the question). Type in the question items in the text boxes. If you wish to add more choices, click the **Add Item** button
- Choose the correct order by using the drop-downs

Creating Random Sets of Questions

Part 1 - Create a Random Selection Folder

- Select **Random Section** from dropdown box on add/edit questions screen
- Name the section
- Choose display options and then **Save**

Creating Random Sets of Questions

Part II

- From Main Quizzing Screen click on new **Green** folder
- Click on **Import** and select questions to import
- Click on **Save**

Creating Random Sets of Questions

Part III

- On the screen that displays all the questions, check and delete any unwanted questions
- Select the number of random questions you want to use and assign a grade value
- Save**
- All questions in a random set have same point value

- Managing the grading screen – watch the drop down box
